We require the school provide an alternate student in the event the award to the selected graduating high school senior does not accept the funds. Funds will be sent to the institution of higher learning for the student, and not awarded as cash.

Eligibility:

- Be a legal resident of Colorado
- Admitted into an undergraduate degree program or related trade school
- Enrolled at least half- time in an institute of higher learning or trade school
- Have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher
- Pursuing a career in natural resources, agriculture, water resources, or related studies.
